**NO**

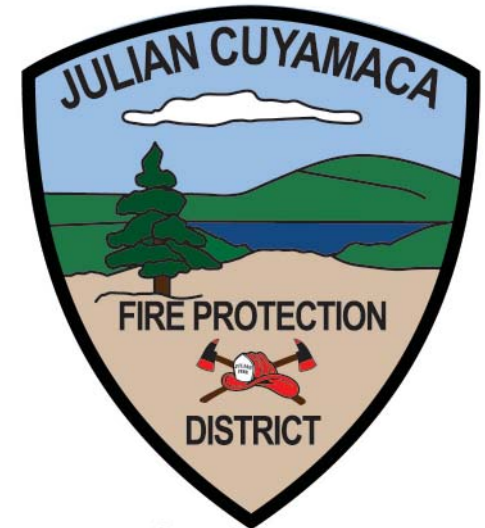
To save JCFPD & ensure there are more firefighters (JCFPD & CalFire) here to serve.

- Regularly scheduled State Curriculum Fire Academies (one is currently in progress that had over 60 applicants).

- Transparency of all operations and finances.
- A new fire board that will faithfully execute the duties of their positions being good stewards of your tax dollars.
